The file that a browser will open when pointed to this directory is called **index.html**, so call the web resume html file `index.html` . You will need to change the access to the files and directories. So, after you have created the directories and files type the following:

```
cd
chmod 711 .           or      chmod ugo +x .
chmod 755 public_html or      chmod ugo +rx public_html
cd public_html
chmod 755 *           or      chmod ugo +rx *
```
