



Dr. Siwei Lyu

Siwei Lyu received his B.S. degree in information science from Peking University, China, in 1997, and his M.S. degree in computer science from Peking University, China, in 2000. He received his Ph.D. degree in computer science from Dartmouth College, Hanover, New Hampshire, USA in 2005.

From 1998 to 2000, he worked at the Founder Research and Development Center (Beijing, China) as a Software Engineer. From 2000 to 2001, he worked at Microsoft Research Asia (then Microsoft Research China) as an Assistant Researcher. From 2005 to 2008, he was a Post-Doctoral Research Associate at the Howard Hughes Medical Institute and the Center for Neural Science of New York University. Starting in 2008, he holds the position of Assistant Professor at the Computer Science Department of University at Albany, State University of New York, Albany, New York, USA.

Prof. Lyu is a member of ACM and IEEE Signal Processing Society.
