

Biosketch:

Raymond L. Lee, Jr. is a Research Professor at the U. S. Naval Academy in Annapolis, Maryland, where he also teaches in the departments of Mathematics and Oceanography. In 1989, Lee earned a Ph.D. in meteorology from Penn State University with a specialization in optics of the atmosphere. Since 1988, Lee's research in atmospheric optics and radiative transfer has been supported by a series of National Science Foundation grants, from which he has published a scholarly book on the natural rainbow's scientific and cultural history (*The Rainbow Bridge: Rainbows in Art, Myth, and Science*, Penn State Press, 2001) and 27 peer-reviewed scientific papers.
