

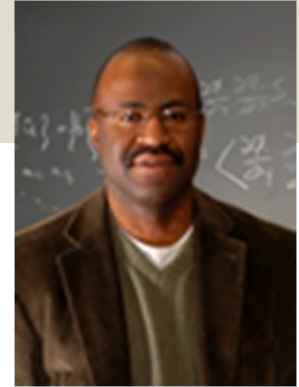

## Dr. Marvin Doyley

Marvin M. Doyley received his Ph.D. degree in biophysics from the University of London in 2000. From 2000 to 2001, he was with the Experimental Echocardiography Department at the Thorax Center in the Netherlands. From 2001 to 2008, he was with the Thayer School of Engineering at Dartmouth College as a research faculty member. In 2008, he joined the faculty of the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering at the University of Rochester, where he is currently an associate professor with a dual appointment in the Department of Biomedical Engineering. His Parametric Imaging Research Laboratory at the University of Rochester concentrates their efforts in the areas of non-invasive vascular imaging, model-based intravascular ultrasound elastography, high frequency nonlinear ultrasound imaging, and molecular imaging for pancreatic cancer.
