

Custom Imaging Science Track Proposal Form

An *Imaging Science Track* is a cohesive group of two or more upper-level courses that provide expertise in a particular sub-discipline of Imaging Science (300 or above, total of at least 6 credit hours). Standard Imaging Science Tracks are listed in the SIS under Academic Requirements. It is possible to create a *custom* Imaging Science Track with the approval of the IS undergraduate program coordinator and the COS IS academic advisor. Use this form if you want to propose a custom track, or if you want to substitute an alternative course for one of the courses in a standard track. This approval form, when signed, becomes part of your academic record toward certification of your degree, and should be submitted as soon as you have identified your track courses.
